

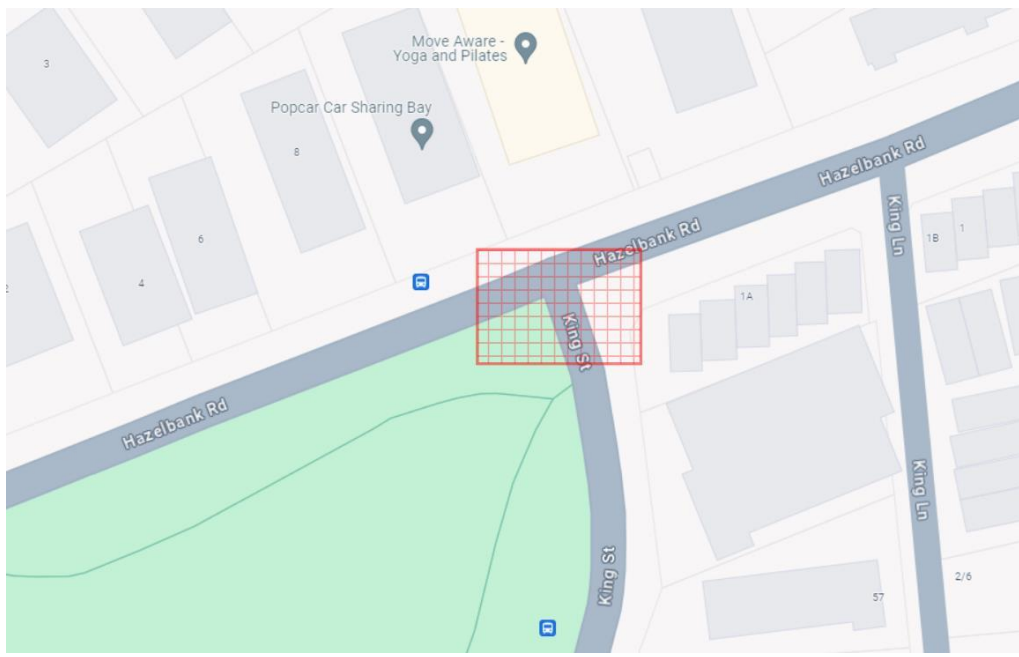
Hazelbank Road and King Street – Wollstonecraft

Pedestrian Refuge Replacement

Dear Resident,

We wish to advise you that North Sydney Council has engaged Civotek to reconstruct the pedestrian Refuge islands and install new kerb blisters at the Intersection of King St and Hazelbank Road, Wollstonecraft. The purpose of the works is to improve the safety of all road users and pedestrians throughout the local area. It is anticipated that the works will commence on:

Monday 20th of May 2024



and will be completed within 3 weeks, weather permitting. Working hours will be between 7am – 5pm.

During the works, traffic controllers will be onsite to guide pedestrians, maintain site access & avoid any obstructions.

Residential and pedestrian access will be maintained at all times during works.

Please ensure no cars are parked near the marked work zones.
