PURPOSE:

The purpose of this report is to seek committee endorsement for temporary road closures associated with the Sydney Marathon 2024, scheduled to be held on Sunday, 15 September 2024.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

- Pont3 has applied for temporary road closures associated with the annual Tata Consultancy Services (TCS) Sydney Marathon event on 15 September 2024.
- The event is a Class 1 State Significant Event and is expected to attract over 40,000 participants across New South Wales, interstate and overseas. The running route showcases Sydney's historic landmarks including the Sydney Harbour Bridge and Opera House.
- Traffic changes related to the event, such as the temporary removal of on-street parking will commence at 8am Friday 13 September 2024, with road closures being undertaken between 3:30am Saturday 14 September 2024 to 12pm Sunday 15 September 2024.

RECOMMENDATION:

- **1. THAT** the Committee endorse the following temporary road closures associated with the Sydney Marathon 2024 on Sunday 15 September 2024 from 3:30am to 9:30pm:
 - On Miller Street, between McLaren Street and the Pacific Highway
 - On Miller Street (northbound), between Blue Street and the Pacific Highway
 - On Miller Street, between Falcon Street and McLaren Street
 - On Carlow Street and side streets, between West Street and Miller Street
 - On Ridge Street and side streets, between West Street and Miller Street
 - On Ridge Street and side streets, between Miller Street and Walker Street
 - On McLaren Street and side streets, between the Pacific Highway and Miller Street
 - On McLaren Street and side streets, between Miller Street and Walker Street

- On Berry Street and side streets, between the Pacific Highway and Miller Street
- On Berry Street and side streets, between Miller Street and Walker Street
- On Mount Street, between William Street and Miller Street
- On Blue Street, between Miller Street and the Pacific Highway
- On Walker Street, between the Pacific Highway and Mount Street

- **2. THAT** the Committee endorse the temporary road closure of Ridge Street, between Miller Street and Walker Street for the setup and operation of the 'VIP Area Build" for the TCS Sydney Marathon 2024 from 9am Saturday 14 September to 12pm Sunday 15 September 2024.

BACKGROUND

REPORT

To facilitate the 2024 TCS Sydney Marathon, temporary road closures are proposed throughout North Sydney CBD on Saturday 14th September and Sunday 15th September 2024.

The Sydney Marathon is a Class 1 State Significant Event. Transport for NSW (TfNSW) and NSW Police will progressively re-open roads, after all infrastructure is removed and the roads are cleaned.

During the road closures, vehicle access will be impacted and managed through alternative arrangements, detours or under traffic control.

Traffic changes related to the event, such as the temporary removal of on-street parking will commence at 8am Friday 13 September 2024, with road closures will being undertaken between 3:30am Saturday 14 September 2024 to 12pm Sunday 15 September 2024.

To ensure the community is well-informed about the road closures and traffic changes, the organiser is required to notify affected stakeholders.

The applicant is required to notify affected stakeholders.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

All cost is required to be borne by the applicant.

LEGISLATION

The temporary road closures are proposed under Section 115 of the NSW Roads Act 1993.
