

ROAD CLOSURES

The Sydney Marathon starting area has moved to North Sydney Oval (St Leonards Park) this year, back to its original starting location from the 2000 Olympic Games. As such, **road closures will be more significant** and vehicle movements around the course will be limited for majority of the day. Residents are urged to avoid unnecessary travel on event day as extensive detours will be in place with longer travel times.

- » Roads around the start area in **North Sydney** will be closed between **3:30am and 12midday**.
- » Major roads and cycleways will be closed between **4am and 3pm** in the Sydney CBD, The Rocks, Millers Point, Barangaroo, Pyrmont, Darlinghurst, Moore Park, Centennial Park, and Kensington.
- » The **Sydney Harbour Bridge, Cahill Expressway, and Western Distributor** will be closed in both directions from 4am–10am.
- » Major roads will be closed from Sydney Opera House in the city through Darlinghurst to Kingsford, including **Macquarie St, College St, Park St**, and sections of **Oxford St, Flinders St, and Anzac Pde** between 4am and 3pm.
- » The **Sydney Harbour Tunnel, Eastern Distributor, Victoria Rd, and The Cross City Tunnel** remain open; however, delays are expected. The Cross City Tunnel will be toll-free from 5am – 3pm.

LOCAL ACCESS

Access will be maintained for residents to enter or exit properties at identified locations during event road closures. Affected streets include **Carlow St, Ridge St, Angelo St and Church St, Kelrose Ln, Bullivant Ln, Ward St, Denison St, Walker St, Little Walker St and Mount St**. SPECIAL EVENT CLEARWAYS

- » Special event clearways will be in effect on roads in North Sydney between **12am (midnight) and 12pm (midday)**. Clearways in other areas along the course will be in effect until **3pm**.
- » **Clearways are strict no-parking zones** and apply to local residents + TfNSW Mobility Scheme Permit holders. Clearways are in place to clear the course of vehicles for the safety of participants.
- » Check the yellow signage carefully when parking on Sunday as well as the night before – vehicles left in clearways will be towed and a fee applies.
- » If your vehicle is towed, call the **Traffic Information Line on 132 701** to find its new location.

TRANSPORT CHANGES

Due to major road closures buses and light rail services will be affected. You may need to change transport modes to continue your trip. Plan your trip and allow extra travel time. Details at transportnsw.info.

You may experience slightly more noise than usual from event related activities, including early morning broadcast helicopters, course entertainment, and general event activities. Event organisers endeavour to keep noise to a minimum.

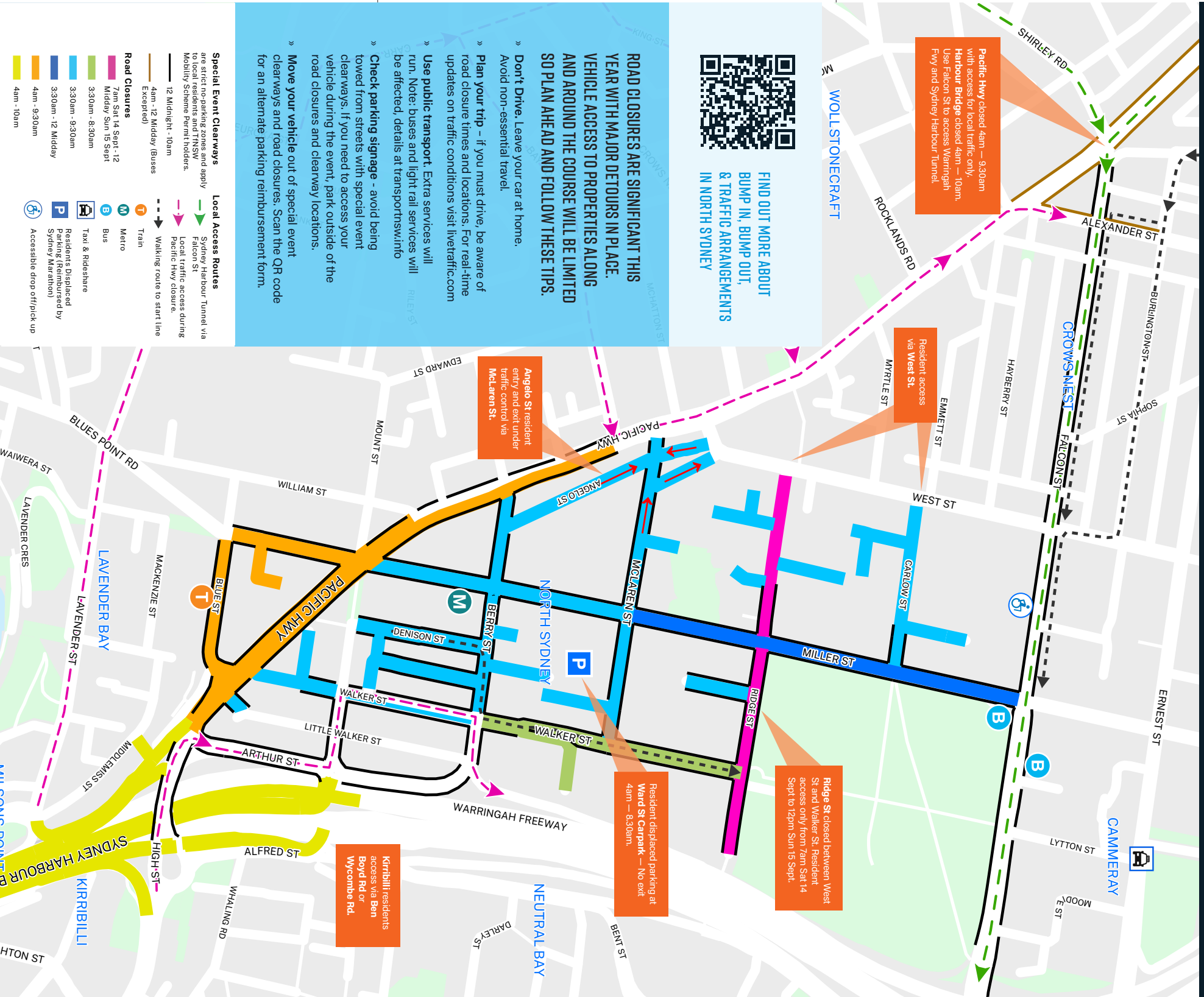

ROAD CLOSURES ARE SIGNIFICANT THIS YEAR WITH MAJOR DETOURS IN PLACE. VEHICLE ACCESS TO PROPERTIES ALONG AND AROUND THE COURSE WILL BE LIMITED SO PLAN AHEAD AND FOLLOW THESE TIPS.

- » Don't Drive. Leave your car at home. Avoid non-essential travel.
- » Plan your trip - if you must drive, be aware of road closure times and locations. For real-time updates on traffic conditions visit live.traffic.com
- » Use public transport. Extra services will be affected, details at transport.nsw.info
- » Check parking signage - avoid being towed from streets with special event clearways. If you need to access your vehicle during the event, park outside of the road closures and clearway locations.
- » Move your vehicle out of special event clearways and road closures. Scan the QR code for an alternate parking reimbursement form.

Special Event Clearways
 are strict no-parking zones and apply to local residents and TNSW Mobility Scheme Permit holders.
