Re: Works Notification – Waverton Park Gross Pollutant Trap

Azbuild Rail and Civil wishes to advise that it will soon be conducting stormwater quality improvement works at Waverton Park, Waverton, on behalf of North Sydney Council.

The project will involve excavation, installation of a new Gross Pollutant Trap (GPT), construction of pits and pipes, and the re-instatement of the surrounds.

The New GPT is expected to stop approximately 40 Tonnes of pollutants, such as plastic, organic matter and sediments, from entering the harbour annually.

These works are scheduled to start on **Monday, March 10**, and be completed within 7 weeks, depending on weather and other factors. Work will take place between 7:00am and 5:00pm, Monday to Friday.

All works are contained within the park, and the site will be fenced to prevent pedestrian access.

Construction traffic will be managed to minimise the impact on local roads, and access to the park will be maintained. Road users and pedestrians are urged to observe all traffic signs, controls and directions.
