Amended Plans - Demolition of an existing supermarket. Construction of a four-storey mixed-use and shop-top housing development with residential apartments, supermarket loading dock, liquor store, and retail premises, 4 levels of basement parking including 189 retail parking spaces, 77 public parking spaces, and 39 residential parking spaces, signage, associated civil and landscaping works, and associated stratum subdivision.
