

Summary of Actions Arising (SOA) Hayes & Kurraba 2024

- **Closed for Council** -

 - b) Response given by Council and awaiting Precinct's reply
 - c) Council has completed related works/tasks

Note: These subcategories are only applied from 2025 onwards)

Update February 2025 The lighting has been inspected & as a result Council's electrician has repaired the stainless-steel bollard lights at the entrance & another at the top of the steps. Prior to lighting inspection Council's Parks team cleared overhanging vegetation from around lights & steps, spider webbing was also removed from lighting where required. Council's Park's & Garden's team has also been asked to confirm the maintenance schedule for this area.</p>	<p>Closed for Council</p>
