PURPOSE:

BACKGROUND

The North Sydney Indoor Sports Centre was originally built in 1999 and designed with Louvres for natural ventilation within the stadium. Over years the louvres were rusted and stuck in certain positions hence limiting the air flow into the sports stadium, resulting in unacceptable temperatures inside the premises in Summer. A Mechanical Consultant JHA Engineers has been engaged to investigate the problems. Detailed investigation and assessment by dynamic simulation and modelling has been undertaken by the Consulting Engineer and the recommendation was to replace all ventilation louvres at the NS Indoor Sports Centre with more air efficient new louvres. The tenant Northern Suburbs Basketball Association (NSBA) has been consulted throughout the process.

Community engagement is not required.
