PURPOSE:

This report is to provide Council with an analysis and recommendation of the tender process for Tender 03/2022 for Anderson Park Sportsfield Lighting Upgrade.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Tenders were called and were received until 3.00 pm on Thursday the 28th of April 2022 for the submission of tenders to undertake the Anderson Park Sportsfield Lighting Upgrade

- 2. THAT** the General Manager be authorised to take any necessary action to implement the decision including entering associated contracts.
- 3. THAT,** once Council has executed the Contract, information relating to the successful tender be published in Council's Register of Contracts as required by Government Information (Public Access) Act 2009 - Part 3 Division 5 - Government Contracts With Private Sector.
- 4. THAT** the Confidential Report relating to matters specified in Section 10A(2)(d) be treated as confidential and remain confidential until Council determines otherwise.

BACKGROUND

A combined significant area Plan of Management/Masterplan was prepared for Anderson Park in response to a resolution made at the Council meeting on 18 April 2016. The new PoM/Masterplan for Anderson Park was completed in February 2019.

The Plan of Management listed key issues identified in relation to Sport and Recreation including lighting as below:

Park Furniture and Lighting - Both pedestrian and sportsfield lighting were identified as issues to be addressed in future. Better lighting at Park entrances and along the path across the foreshore is needed, and, when the playing field is 'shifted' west, away from the foreshore, the sportsfield lighting may require modification.

TENDERS RECEIVED

The methodology adopted to undertake the tender evaluation of Tender 03/2022 was based on selection criteria outlined in the tender documents and in accordance with the Local Government Act 1993 and the Local Government (General) Regulation 2005.

Open tenders were called and were received until until 3.00 pm on Thursday 28 April 2022 via Tenderlink. At close of tenders, three (3) tenders were received. Listed in **strict alphabetical order**, the tenderers were:
